## What FREE academic programs / activities do we offer for youth?

#### English and Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics Instruction

This instructional time during the after-school program provides academic skill Development opportunities for mastery in English and Language Arts and Mathematics. This is dedicated instructional time that is aligned with Common Core Standards with activities that are grade level specific and subject matter driven.



**STEM** Enrichment is time on task for exploring the learning theme for the current program year. Planned activities during this time expose 21st CCLC Program participants to new learning environments through project-based and

Hands-on learning in science, technology, engineering, or math. Learning opportunities are applied through real world experience as we uncover the theme for the year.

#### **Positive Youth Development (PYD)**

Center's Choice is a period where Project Cares 21st CCLC students engage in activities and strategies that promote Positive Youth Development. Program offerings support participants in developing a sense of competence, usefulness, belonging, and empowerment. During the 2017-2018 program year, students will participate in a semester-long Career Development program for teens and an ACT Test Preparation / study skills development program.

(PBL) Project Based Learning/ Entrepreneurial Program: Video, Music, Graphics Design & Coding Students will have the opportunity to create and build websites, write music and develop a TV program for Access One. They will also have an opportunity to explore other career opportunities in Photography, Embroidery, Heat Press and Graphic Arts & Design.

Homework and Tutoring Lab Each day the after -school program provides dedicated time for homework assistance and tutoring (e.g. individualized instruction, one on one and small group instruction, etc.) provided by 21st CCLC teachers/tutors.
